


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Preparation #1: Run to the Arms of My Father


1. Let God's love minister to you while listening to "[I Will Run to the Arms of My Father](#)" by Dennis Jernigan.


6. Discover what the Bible reveals about [“love”](#) to start a fresh, new love relationship with the Father and the Son.

9. Read the [The Furious Longing of God](#) by Brennan Manning to experience God’s intense, consuming love for His children.




Preparation #2: Check for the Elijah Error






Preparation #3: Come Out Of the Cave



4. Listen to this song [“Take Courage”](#) by Lindy Conant to stir faith in your heart for what God wants to do in our nation in this generation.




5. Read this short article by John Piper on [Christian Courage](#) and listen to his message [“The Need for Christian Courage”](#).

8. Watch the movie [Courageous](#) to be inspired by the stories of a few courageous families.





Preparation #6: Beat Loneliness





3. Read this short article in the Christian post, [Billy Graham's Warning to American Churches: 'Prepare for Persecution'](#).


8. Commit to praying for persecuted Christians around the world using Open Door's monthly prayer [calendar](#).




8. Dig into a quality discipleship resource. Ask your pastor for a recommendation.

Different people will view different groups as being both false and cultish. When researching this issue, be careful to know who is making the determination and what criteria they are using.






